


BOILES LOGINE


SYNOPSIS








BOTTPECS SEASON ONE EPISODES



EPISODE 1: "Banding Together"

Camrin's social ineptness is on full display as he struggles at school. With no luck making friends, he begins building his own robotic friends out of scrap parts from his father's laboratory.

Episode 2: "Turntable Mayhem"

Camrin introduces a DJ turntable set to see if his robot band can respond to different styles of music. Once he turns the turntables on, mayhem happens.

Episode 3: "Do Not Disturb"

Mr. Ramsey escalates his snooping and tries to videotape the robots jamming and making music. Cameron and the robots do their best to stop Mr. Ramsey's efforts.

EPISODE 4: "Turn The Mic Up"

Mr. Ramsey is taking a vacation. Camrin and the group are excited to jam to music without needing headphones. FurryPeg continues to get into mischief, which almost sabotages everything.

EPISODE 5: "Sound Investigation"

Ethical scientists are sent to investigate the legitimacy of these sophisticated AI robots. Camrin hides his robots and gets his father to step in and stop this investigation.

EPISODE 6: "Mic Check"

Camrin uses Buddy to hack into the school system to check a grade he suspects was graded incorrectly. Camrin's grade check exposes hidden truths about the teacher.

EPISODE 7: "Caught On Camera"

Camrin successfully soundproofs his basement with egg crates and mattress foam. A secretly recorded viral video puts Camrin and his robots at risk of exposing their technology.

EPISODE 8: "Going Viral"

The viral video has Emily receiving offers from a record label and now must make a desperate choice. Camrin feels closer to a worldwide concert with his robot friends, but he needs a plan.

EPISODE 9: "Search And Seizure"

Department of ethical scientists gets a court order to search and seize the robots from Camrin's home. Camrin and the robots do everything in their power to stop it.

EPISODE 10: "Bring AI Music Back To Life"

Camrin tries to get back on track by creating music and planning the concert, but it is extremely difficult because the robots have been disassembled.

EPISODE 11: "AI Improvement"

The robots are reassembled, but their programming is quite different. They must figure out a new coding solution before the oncoming concert.

HOOK

What happens when an introverted, shy kid with no friends wants to be an intergalactic music superstar? He creates emotional AI robot friends to take his place on stage to express his musical talents to the universe.

THEME

Their open-ended adventures are rooted in morality lessons that make the characters become more empathetic of one another. The robots learn about their distinct differences but also their creative commonalities. The robots learn from Camerin what it means to be human, to be a friend but also what it means to be an Al. They work on trust and teamwork through their interconnected friendships while expressing themselves through their music.

TONE

Peg bots has light mischief mixed with adventure as Camrin and the robots create hilarious inventions and creations from day to day. Wild adventures and comedic scenarios cater to a youth-oriented demographic and core family audience. For example, Furry Peg can be compared to the comedic stylings of a "Minion."

BACKGROUND

The setting takes place in a remote area on a planet in the Andromeda system where Camerin does not have access to a lot of friends. Because of his father, he has grown up around AI and technology. He has become a super prodigy at a young age, coming up with his own robotic inventions. He watches all the interplanetary musical stardom shows on the interplanetary internet. He practices so that one day he can play a huge concert on earth, his parent's original home. Each day he goes into his father's advanced laboratory to daydream, create and play with AI (artificial intelligence) robots.
